My dear Mr. Hildreth:

The Foreign Department has called the attention of the Medical Department to an action of the Reference Committee of the South China Mission recommending the payment of several medical bills among which is one for you totaling \$1,157.96 (Mex.).

According to the rules of the Board of Managers, we must have a special action of the Board on all appropriations exceeding \$500. This rule must, of course, apply to your medical bill. Although the Board always takes the most kindly and sympathetic attitude toward large medical expenses such as yours, it has repeatedly expressed its opinion to the Medical Department that we should have fairly detailed information before considering an appropriation.

In view of this policy, I am writing to ask you to send me a statement of your medical account indicating in a general way the various items, and the dates of each. The total should include all your medical expenses without deducting the first \$50.00 to be paid by the missionary in each fiscal year, and the additional 20% to be paid by the missionary.

It will be helpful to us, in bringing this to the attention of the Board, if you can also write us briefly concerning the illness which made it necessary to incur the expense.

In view of the fact that the Medical Department works quite largely through the health supervisors on the field, we are also writing to Dr. Lesher about this matter, asking that he also give us a brief statement about it. It would doubtless be helpful, therefore, if you would send him a copy of your reply to this letter. If you prefer, you may send all the information to him, asking him to forward it to us with such comment

as he may desire to make. I am sure that you will understand that in asking for this information, we do not question at all the legitimacy of the expenses, we take these steps simply to be sure that we are administering the denomination's funds in the proper way. Although, of course, I cannot predict just what the Board's action will be. I am confident through past experience that their attitude will be most sympathetic.

Dear Dr. Alden,

Your letter of Feb 7, arrived a few days ago and we do not feel at all offended, but are glad to know that a strict <sup>investigation of the</sup> ~~account~~ <sup>is</sup> use of the Board's money is being insisted upon. <sup>As far as we are concerned</sup> ~~As far as we are concerned~~ <sup>we certainly</sup> ~~we certainly~~ <sup>hope</sup> ~~hope~~ <sup>that there are some</sup> ~~that there are some~~ <sup>fair</sup> ~~fair~~ <sup>estimates</sup> ~~estimates~~ <sup>expensed</sup> ~~expensed~~ in this account.

We surely thought that a covering letter concerning my medical expenses had gone to the Board; but did not know that such a detailed account went in to the Medical Committee of ~~Chao chowfu~~ <sup>Chao chowfu</sup>.

To restate briefly -

I was ill and <sup>went</sup> ~~went~~ <sup>to</sup> ~~to <sup>Peking</sup> ~~Peking~~ in 1922 where I received radium treatment for a supposed fibroid tumor. This medical bill has been all settled long ago.~~

In 1925, my symptoms returned and the doctors were <sup>absolutely</sup> ~~absolutely~~ <sup>certain</sup> ~~certain <sup>that</sup> ~~that <sup>some</sup> ~~some~~ <sup>time</sup> ~~time~~ <sup>whether</sup> ~~whether <sup>I had cancer</sup> ~~I had cancer~~ <sup>or not.</sup> ~~or not.~~~~~~~~

They offered us two alternatives - either

(1) the whole family must go home at once.

(2) I must go to Peking alone for my operation, ~~and~~ <sup>and</sup> must stay in the north for a year.

~~My wife~~ <sup>My wife</sup> ~~if I should~~ <sup>decide</sup> go to Peking to stay a year, they could make arrangements for my children to be brought to me as soon as I was able to care for them, and Mr. Hildreth should ~~of course~~ spend his summer vacation with us.

We talked and prayed about the matter and it did not seem fair to the workers as all to go home, when we had been out only about three years, <sup>with no sleep time & having to long & really suffered to stay here</sup> and to make that ~~great expense~~ for the Board. <sup>It took only a few minutes</sup> ~~to figure out~~ <sup>to figure out</sup> that it was far ~~cheaper to stay here~~ <sup>cheaper to stay here</sup> ~~than to go to the Board~~ <sup>than to go to the Board</sup> ~~and to make that great expense~~ <sup>and to make that great expense</sup>

We decided to ~~make~~ <sup>stay</sup> in China, with the understanding that the ~~Board~~ <sup>Board</sup> would forward <sup>to us</sup> the money for medical our expenses, medical travel, and ~~the~~ cost of living in the north.

After my operation was over, <sup>the doctors found</sup> what my trouble was not malignant. <sup>but when it was malignant, it was</sup> In every way thro the whole year, it seems as if God's help was evident. I was fearful lest the cost of living would be beyond reason, but not only was my Board <sup>no</sup> always reduced after I had been in <sup>no</sup> place for some time - and I feel that

it would be almost impossible to duplicate  
the many fortunate my experiences.

I am sending the detailed account again to Dr.  
Lecher in case he cares to send it to you.

I will make a brief summary in case he does  
not want to send the ~~note book~~ book in which it is  
written. and will hold the note-book in  
which all our expenses are recorded in  
detail ready to send in case Dr. Lecher  
thinks it best to send that on.
