Rosser-Hauser Family Papers

Background

Papers of Isaiah Hauser (1834-1909), and his wife, Jeanette Gallagher Shepherd Hauser (1840-1923), Methodist Episcopal missionaries to India beginning in 1860. They were appointed by the Board of Foreign Missions of the Methodist Episcopal Church. Isaiah was a businessman (Indian tea), inventor, writer, and owner/editor of *The Christian Statesman*. Jeanette was a writer, and President of the Women's Christian Temperance Union of India, following her appointment by Frances Willard. Her book *The Orient and Its People* was published in 1876. The collection also includes papers of their children Miriam Hauser Rosser, Arthur T. Hauser, and Jeanette Hauser Jobbins.
