29. WHERE WERE YOU AND WHAT DID YOU DO DURING THE WAR? Was never stopped our
school work. School was removed away 100 miles twice. 1st
time 3 yrs, second time 1 yr. 1944 June, when Japs came
to school, we walked away. I carried my family, wife
and 6 children with me. Most children walked with me
on foot for 100 miles (300 li) on foot in 5 days. Enemy
soldiers came near the place in Yiyang where we stayed
within one or two miles. My home in the country was
so much destroyed that the building is still standing empty now.
We soon opened the school in Pnfa, about as many students
as before followed us. (about 900 stud).

YOU INTERNED, CAPTURED, BOMBED, ETC?

I had about 1000 pounds books both Chinese and foreign. They were sent to a relative of me in Yiyang out in country. When the enemy troops approached, it was rumored they would burn all books. So my relative buried the books under ground. Rain continued for 21 days. Until I knew and dug them out, all were destroyed.

One of my cousin was killed by the Japs. The dead body was swollen when that was secretly taken away to be buried by my far relatives.

My wife's grandfather was taken captured by the enemy and struck. He was so stimulated and got sick and died within a few month, when my wife and I was 100 miles away and could not see him dead.

The Japs stayed in my building in the country for 3 days. Soon after they left there, I went home and saw on person all desolate conditions, how they imprisoned captured in my granary, how they killed people and threw away in the hinter of my building and all sorts of cruelties and atrocities.

It was so thrilling to see women and children carrying their necessities, farmers leading their oxen and running away when Japs came. Hundreds and thousands of them did not know where to go.

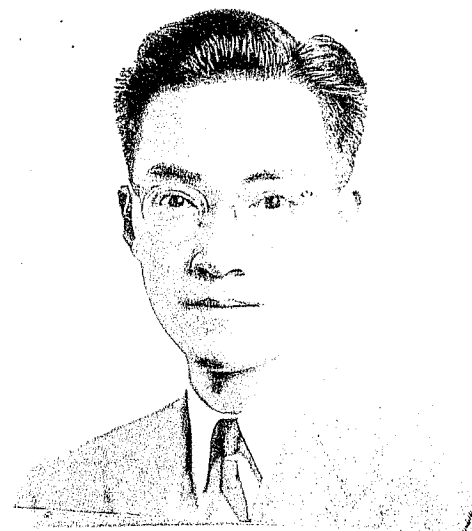
