My dear Mrs. Gamble:

Your generous and spontaneous action of Friday gave a much greater stimulation to our movement in behalf of the Women's College, than you can possibly realize. Coming at the end of an extremely strenuous day, it relieved me of a certain feeling of discouragement and sent Doctor Stuart to his hotel with a broad smile on his face. I am not sure whether one suggestion I made to you was quite intelligible. May I repeat it here?

We are trying to place the income of the Women's College needed for its present budget on a stable basis. Your generous pledge helps to assure us of this as a condition we can bring about gradually in the course of the next five years. Is it possible to go one step further as regards your share of the \$100,000 endowment fund, by paying each year to the University the interest on the unpaid portion of your pledge, somewhat as follows:

First payment February (?) 1930	\$2,000.
Interest February (?) 1930 on \$2,000.....	490.
Second payment February, 1931	2,000.
Interest February 1931 on \$6,000	360.
Third payment February 1932	2,000.
Interest February 1932 on \$4,000.....	240.
Fourth payment February 1933	2,000.
Interest February 1933	120.
Fifth payment February 1934	2,000.

I hope you will not think this suggestion presuming. It is in line with a policy which has become pretty well established in the case of our best managed institutions, of asking donors of buildings to include a sufficient amount to endow the upkeep of the building.



My dear Mr. Gamble

This is to inform you that at a recent meeting of the Finance Committee action was taken in relation to your letter of February 6, 1930 relative to the gift of \$25,000.00 to Yenching University. This letter set forth a plan whereby the income from certain trust funds would be forwarded to the University quarterly, these payments to be approximately \$1,562.50 and to continue until sixteen had been made and a total of \$25,000.00 accrued. It is understood that this sum is to be used for permanent endowment of Yenching University during a period of 25 years and during that period only income is to be used, but at the expiration of said 25-year period a part or all of the principal amount may be used for current expenses if it is the wisdom of the Board of Trustees of said University.

In confirming the minutes of the previous meeting, wherein acceptance of this very generous gift was made, the Executive Committee and the Finance Committee in session on March 28 informally expressed their very deep appreciation for your generosity and thoughtfulness in the setting up of this fund. The action taken on February 24, 1930, when the gift was accepted, reads as follows:

"P-2773 VOTED that in behalf of the Trustees of Yenching University, this Committee very gratefully accepts and agrees to the terms as set forth by Mr. Sidney D. Gamble in tendering the \$25,000.00 gift and as indicated in Appendix B attached to the minutes, and further desires to express its very sincere appreciation for the generosity as well as wise provisions on the part of the donors."



My dear Mr. Gamble:

Let me acknowledge receipt of your letter of February 17th with its enclosed check for \$1,171.87, being the thirteenth payment on the Mary Huggins Gamble Fund for the Endowment of Yenching University. We are enclosing herewith a receipt for this amount.

We are sorry to learn that reduced income on the trust fund from which these quarterly payments have been made, has necessitated making this payment 25% less than former ones, but we realize that such reductions are inevitable in the present period of depression.

This reduction raises one question which should be clarified for our records. Your letter of February 6, 1930 in which you set forth the procedure by which you planned to create the Mary Huggins Gamble Endowment Fund of \$25,000, stated that it was your intention to pay over this sum in sixteen payments covering a period of four years, with, however, the reservation that payments might be discontinued at any time if you should so determine. The question now raised is whether you will still find it possible to complete the original figure of \$25,000 for this endowment fund by continuing payments somewhat beyond the four years originally contemplated, or whether it will still be necessary for you to discontinue payments at the end of the four year period.

As you know, your payments are being matched by an equal amount from the Rockefeller Foundation, so any reduction in these payments means the loss of an equal amount from the Rockefeller Foundation. Since the Foundation will continue to match contributions on our outstanding pledges paid in before June 30, 1935, there would still be time for us to gain the full benefit of the Rockefeller Foundation payments if you should find it possible to complete this \$25,000 fund by continuing quarterly payments into next year to make up for the present reduction.

I can assure you that the Yenching Trustees are profoundly grateful to you for the generosity with which you have built up the Mary Huggins Gamble Endowment Fund, and that they will heartily support whatever decision you may make regarding these final payments.

Dear Mr and Mrs Gamble:-

You have been very materially responsible for the present campus at Yenching and I am delighted to be able to send you under separate cover a little pamphlet by William Hung and a map of the campus by Stephen Tsai. This last was prepared for use in the campaign for one million dollars local currency in China.
