Got underwear yesterday, duplicate for Loxing's books, etc. Tell the youngest rascal that his extra Valentine came on April Fool's Day, so I don't know whether it's for this year or the next. Your bird story of material for our house just arrived, confirming expectations of the stuff itself and the builder. Will wish to see Chairman of Directors. Probable duration one week, but might be ten days if pull is heavier one way than the other. Arranged today for Japanese Embassy (now Consulate-General) to play baseball on the part of the University field, not used by Red Swastika Soup Kitchen. A real improvement, I hope. Your weekly magazine was much appreciated. 982 in classes at main University Building now. Much love
